AMERICAN INDIAN SCHOLARS



American Indian Scholars
provides a **full tuition and fee waiver**
for eligible American Indian students to attend a
Minnesota public two- or four-year college or university.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Students must meet one of the following:

- ✓ Be eligible for Minnesota resident tuition and an enrolled member or citizen of *any* federally recognized American Indian Tribe or Canadian First Nation; or
- ✓ Be an enrolled member or citizen of a Minnesota Tribal Nation, regardless of resident tuition status

Additionally, students must:

- ✓ Be enrolled in an undergraduate certificate, diploma, or degree program at a Minnesota State institution or a campus of the University of Minnesota
- ✓ Not have already obtained a bachelor's degree;
- ✓ Not have been enrolled 12 full time semesters or the equivalent at the college-level; and
- ✓ Be meeting Satisfactory Academic Progress requirements

WHICH SCHOOLS ARE ELIGIBLE?

- ✓ All Minnesota State Colleges and Universities
- ✓ All University of Minnesota campuses

HOW DO I APPLY?

Student eligibility is determined by the college or university. Each institution has its own application process. Contact your institution's financial aid office for more information.
