Scenario Two Providers Overview: When Calculating Only One Provider is Necessary

- **Student:** Morgan Lee
- **Term:** Fall Semester (15 weeks)
- **Enrollment:** 6 credits, Undergraduate
- **Child Care Providers:** Licensed Child Care Center and Aunt Linda
- **Children:** 1 child enrolled
- **First Provider (Weeks 1–15):**
 - Daycare cost: \$140/week
 - Hours: 20 hours/week
- **Second Provider (Weeks 1–15):**
 - Child care cost \$10/hour
 - Hours: 10 hours/week
- **Maximum Term Award for student SAI and Enrollment:** \$1,625
- **Student checked no to MFIP and CCAP benefits**

- **Student:** Stan Peterson
- **Term:** Fall Semester (15 weeks)
- **Enrollment:** 15 credits, Undergraduate
- **Child Care Providers:** Licensed Child Care Center and Grandma Patty
- **Children:** 1 child enrolled
- **First Provider (Weeks 1–15):**
 - Daycare cost: \$100/week
 - Hours: 15 hours/week
- **Second Provider (Grandma Patty) (Weeks 1–15):**
 - Child care cost \$5/hour
 - Hours: 10 hours/week
- **Maximum Term Award for student SAI and Enrollment:** \$3,250
- **Student checked no to MFIP and CCAP benefits**

Step 4: Combine Awards keeping in mind [SAI – Credit Level Enrollment Status Conversion Chart maximums](#)

The maximum amount this student can receive per semester per child is \$3,250 based on this students enrollment level and SAI.

- **First Calculator Award:** \$1,500

- **Second Calculator Award:** \$375
- **Combined Award:** \$1,875
 - \$1,875 < \$3,250 maximum term award.

Step 5: Document and Adjust Award

- Manually Adjust Award to \$1,875 by clicking 'UPDATE CHILD INFO' button and enter \$1,875 for the Fall Award.
- Keep all notes regarding calculation on students file in the case of an audit.
- Communicate Child Care Grant award to student by promptly sending an Award Notice.
