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About the Office of Higher Education

The Minnesota Office of Higher Education is a cabinet-level state agency providing students with financial aid programs and information to help them gain access to postsecondary education. The agency also serves as the state's clearinghouse for data, research and analysis on postsecondary enrollment, financial aid, finance and trends.

The Minnesota State Grant Program is the largest financial aid program administered by the Office of Higher Education, awarding more than \$243 million annually in need-based grants to Minnesota residents attending eligible colleges, universities and career schools in Minnesota. The agency oversees other state scholarship programs, tuition reciprocity programs, a student loan program, Minnesota's 529 College Savings Plan, licensing and early college awareness programs for youth.

About This Report

This is a legislative-mandated report. As requested by Minnesota Statutes, section 3.197, this report cost approximate \$5,243.45 to prepare, including staff time.

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Executive Summary

Providing direct financial aid to students is a critical part of the Minnesota Office of Higher Education's mission. There are nearly a dozen financial aid programs outlined in state statute that the Office administers. This report provides an overview of these programs as required by MS 136A.053.

Programs in this report include:

- **Fostering Independence Grant:** Grants to former foster youth that may cover up to the student's cost of attendance.
- **Grants for Students with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities:** Provides students with intellectual and developmental disabilities financial assistance for tuition and fees.
- **Grants to Student Teachers in Shortage Areas:** Provides financial assistance to eligible student teachers, specifically those who intend to teach in a license shortage area or rural school district after graduating and receiving their teaching license.
- **Minnesota Indian Scholarship Program:** Grants to undergraduate and graduate students who are of one-fourth or more American Indian ancestry or an enrolled member or citizen of a federally recognized American Indian tribe or Canadian First Nation.
- **Minnesota State Grant Program:** The state's primary need-based aid program, available to eligible Minnesota-resident undergraduate students at public and private institutions.
- **North Star Promise:** Last-dollar grants covering costs up to tuition and fees at public institutions in Minnesota for eligible students with less than \$80,000 family adjusted gross income. Students receiving Pell Grants may also be eligible for a North Star Promise Plus grant, which matches a portion of the student's Pell Grant, as funding allows.
- **Postsecondary Child Care Grant:** Helps eligible low-income students offset the cost of existing out-of-pocket childcare expenses for their young children while the student attends classes, works, or studies
- **State Work Study:** Provides funding for part time on-or off-campus jobs for eligible undergraduate, graduate, and vocational students to help students pay the cost of their higher education.
- **Summer Academic Enrichment:** Provides stipends to cover all or a portion of the direct cost for students in grades 3-11 who participate in free and reduced-price lunch programs to attend eligible academic enrichment programs during the summer months.
- **Underrepresented Student Teacher Grants:** Provides financial assistance to eligible student teachers, specifically those who belong to a racial or ethnic group underrepresented in the Minnesota teacher workforce.

Each section lists summary information on program applicants, recipients, total awards, and average awards for the most recent aid year by institution and student demographic information. Persistence and completion data is also included by institution and student demographic category for programs that have been in existence for six or more years. Statewide average debt by award type is also included for recipients of programs that have been in existence for six or more years

Introduction

Providing direct financial aid to students is a critical part of the Minnesota Office of Higher Education's mission. There are nearly a dozen financial aid programs outlined in state statute that the Office administers. This report provides an overview of these programs as required by MS 136A.053.

About the Data

Data on all state aid programs are reported to the Office of Higher Education by institutions administering programs and are reported at the student level. Data includes information required to calculate the student's award, including tuition and fees charged, enrollment intensity, and other financial information as applicable.

MS 136A.121 subd. 18 requires institutions participating in the Minnesota State Grant program to report data on student enrollment, twice annually, and on awards conferred, once annually. Data are submitted at the student level and include information on student demographic information, by term (for enrollment) and by fiscal year (for awards conferred). This information is linked to our financial aid data to provide summary reporting on financial aid programs by student demographics.

Institution Types

Institutions included in this report are those participating in state aid programs. Institutions may confer a range of award types, including certificates and degrees. In some cases, state aid programs are also available to students pursuing graduate degrees. For the purposes of this report, institutions are grouped into the following categories:

- **Minnesota State Colleges:** Community and technical colleges from the Minnesota State system. These institutions typically confer associate degrees and certificates of one to four years in length, also referred to as sub-baccalaureate certificates.
- **Minnesota State Universities:** Universities from the Minnesota State system. These institutions typically confer bachelor's degrees and graduate degrees.
- **University of Minnesota:** Universities from the University of Minnesota system. These institutions typically confer bachelor's degrees and graduate degrees.
- **Private Non-Profit Institutions:** Private institutions located in Minnesota with a non-profit tax designation. These institutions may offer a range of award types, including certificates and degrees.
- **Private For-Profit Institutions:** Private institutions located in Minnesota without a non-profit tax designation. These institutions may offer a range of award types, including certificates and degrees.

Award Types

- **Sub-baccalaureate Certificates:** This category includes certificates and diplomas from three award levels in OHE's awards conferred data based on the length of the program: 1) awards less than one year, 2) awards at least one but less than two years, and 3) awards at least two but less than four years. These

awards include programs that require the completion of a specialization program of study at the postsecondary level (below the baccalaureate degree).

- **Associate Degrees:** Awards that normally require at least two but less than four years of full-time equivalent college-level work.
- **Bachelor's Degrees:** Awards that normally require at least four but not more than five years of full-time equivalent college-level work. Also includes bachelor's degrees in which the normal four years of work are completed in three years.
- **Master's Degrees:** Awards that require the successful completion of a program of study of generally one or two full-time equivalent academic years of work beyond the bachelor's degree. Some of these degrees may require more than two full-time equivalent academic years of work.
- **Graduate Certificates:** This category includes both post-baccalaureate certificates and post-master's certificates. These certificates require the completion of an organized program of study beyond the bachelor's level (for post-baccalaureate certificates) or beyond the master's level (for post-masters' certificates).
- **Doctoral – Research and Scholarship:** A Ph.D. or other doctor's degree that requires advanced work beyond the master's level, including the preparation and defense of a dissertation based on original research, or the planning and execution of an original project demonstrating substantial artistic or scholarly achievement.
- **Doctoral-Professional Practice:** A doctor's degree that is conferred upon completion of a program providing the knowledge and skills for the recognition, credential, or license required for professional practice. These include awards in law, medicine, and other specialized degrees. Awards coded in this award category include law, medicine, and other specialized professional degrees. Degrees requiring a "research" designation are categorized as doctoral degrees.

Additional Definitions and Data Notes

- **Aid Year:** The year in which the student receives aid. Aid years follow the state fiscal year calendar, which begins on July 1 annually. For example, a student receiving aid for any term in the 2023-2024 academic year falls under the 2024 aid year.
- **Applicant:** A student who met baseline eligibility requirements for the aid program in the aid year specified. Eligibility requirements vary by program, and additional information regarding program eligibility can be found on the program webpage. For most programs, students must meet Minnesota residency requirements for state financial aid outlined in MS 136a.101 Subd. 8.
- **Recipient:** A student who received an award for that aid program in the aid year specified. Statewide totals display the distinct count of recipients. However, a student may be eligible to receive an award at multiple institutions during the aid year. For this reason, statewide totals may differ from the distinct count of recipients by institution.
- **Persistence:** For the purposes of this report, persistence is defined as when a student who receives aid during one aid year enrolls in the following aid year at the same institution or completes an award.

- **Completion:** For the purposes of this report, completion is defined as when a student who receives aid during one aid year completes any award at their institution in the same aid year or any subsequent aid year.
- **Average Cumulative Debt:** The average debt accumulated by students graduating for that award type and institution. Cumulative debt is reported by institutions as debt accumulated at that institution for the award that the student was pursuing. Debt data accumulated at other institutions or for other award types is not included in this total. For the purposes of this report, average cumulative debt is only reported for aid recipients who were newly-entering students at the time of entry into their program. Debt data for graduates is only available for students completing awards in 2024 or later.
- **Average Years to Award Completion:** Number of years between first grant receipt and completion. For the purposes of this report, average years to completion is only reported for aid recipients who were newly-entering students at the time of matriculation.
- **Statewide Totals:** Applicant and recipient counts in this visual represent the unduplicated count of students who applied for and received aid for the selected program. Some students may enroll in more than one institution in a single academic year. Therefore, state and sector totals may not match the sum of institutional totals.
- **Data Suppression:** In instances where there are fewer than 10 students in a category, the data is suppressed and noted with (*).
- **University of Minnesota Rochester:** Financial aid for the University of Minnesota Rochester is administered through the University of Minnesota Twin Cities campus. Totals in this report for the University of Minnesota Twin Cities include financial aid for the Rochester campus.

Fostering Independence Grant

The Fostering Independence Grant (FIG) is a financial aid program that seeks to eliminate barriers to higher education for Minnesota resident students who were in the foster care system. Grants cover the cost of attendance at any eligible Minnesota public or participating private college and university.

Grants to Student Teachers in Shortage Areas

The Minnesota Student Teacher Grants (STG) is a financial aid program that provides financial assistance to eligible student teachers as they complete the required 12-week or more student teaching experience to acquire a Tier 3 teaching license. To be eligible for a grant, the student must: be enrolled in an Professional Educator Licensing and Standards Board (PELSB)-approved Minnesota teacher preparation program that requires at least 12 weeks of student teaching for a Tier 3 teaching license, meet satisfactory academic progress as defined by the institution, not be in default on a federal or state student loan, and demonstrate financial need. The grant for Student Teachers in Shortage Areas (STSA) specifically assists students who intend to teach in a license shortage area (as defined by PELSB) or rural school district after graduating and receiving their teaching license.
